

Agriculture, environmental and animal care common KSBs

This document is intended for use with Trailblazer groups as a tool to support writing knowledge, skills and behaviour statements and grading descriptors. Statements and descriptors should be contextualised and altered relevant to the subject sector and level and are dependent on the chosen assessment method. Suggestions offered should be seen as a starting point for further refinements. Changes to command verbs and the way the KSBs are rewarded for may need to be applied in line with the assessment method used.
